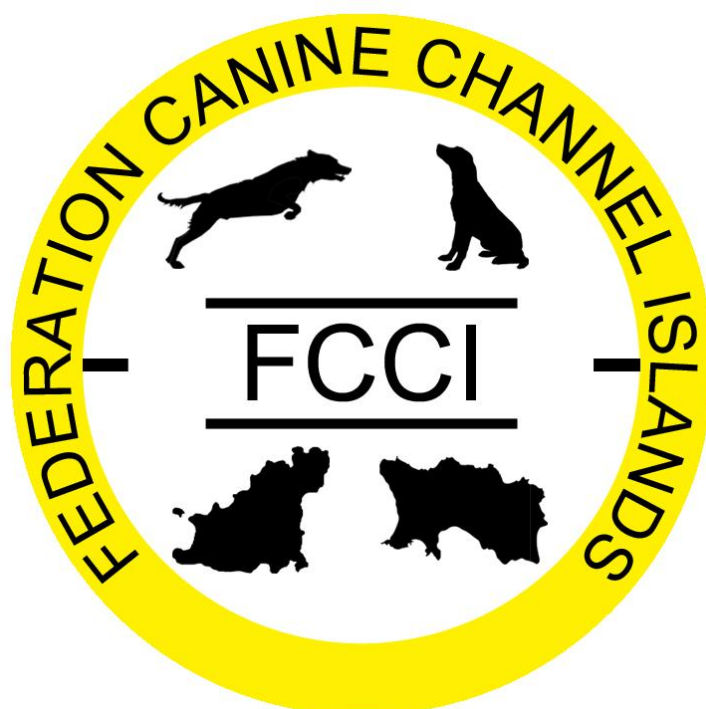


# Federation Canine Channel Islands

(FCCI)

# Rules

## 1. Name

The name shall be Federation Canine Channel Islands (*generally referred to as the FCCI*).

## 2. The objects for which the Federation is established are:

- a. To promote / support canine activities, specifically canine shows.
- b. To create and maintain regulations for appropriate canine shows for clubs to follow in the Channel Islands.
- c. To long term, coordinate with clubs the raising of funds (held in relevant clubs designated account) from various shows throughout the year with the aim of securing a permanent venue for training and shows.

## 3. Representation and meetings

The FCCI will meet when required to co-ordinate and agree on its above objectives. Any meeting called for this purpose will be made up of representatives from canine clubs in the Channel Islands that wish to participate (a club can have up to 2 representatives). For the purpose of the meeting a chairperson and secretary will be elected for that meeting by the representatives present at the meeting. If any queries / issues arise after the meeting the elected people at that meeting will co-ordinate until the next meeting.

## 4. Finance

The FCCI in its current format will not have any bank accounts.

## 5. Powers of the FCCI

- a. The FCCI will not have any powers over any of the participating clubs, each must be responsible for the running of their club and any issues that arise day to day or at shows.
- b. If a club does not run shows under the regulations agreed by the FCCI they will be asked to stop using them.
